Agave americana



CA Native:	No
Plant Community:	Non-native. Does not grow naturally in CA.
Form:	Perennial succulent
Size:	6-12'
Light:	Sun
Water:	Little to no water
WUCOLS:	1-4, 6 (L); 5 (N/A)
Soil:	Adaptable, dry soils
Flowers/Berries:	12-25' bloom stalk with yellow bloom in June or July, typically at about 10 years
Deer resistance:	Moderate
Fire resistance:	Yes
Wildlife value:	Shelter and shade for small birds, mammals, and reptiles
Uses/Comments:	Be cautious of sharp spines. Plant dies after flowering.
