<b>CA Native:</b>	Yes; Ventura to Death Valley to Baja, CA; Also east to Texas
<b>Plant Community:</b>	Coastal Sage Scrub, Creosote Bush Scrub; Streams washes, salt marshes below 2,000'
<b>Form:</b>	Evergreen shrub; Loosely branched
<b>Size:</b>	10-12'
<b>Light:</b>	Full sun to part shade
<b>Temperature:</b>	
<b>Water:</b>	Low; Regular for best appearance
<b>WUCOLS:</b>	1-6 (N/A)
<b>Soil:</b>	Adaptable
<b>Flowers/Berries:</b>	Inconspicuous white male and female flowers on separate plants late summer through fall
<b>Deer resistance:</b>	
<b>Fire resistance:</b>	No
<b>Wildlife value:</b>	Seeds provide food for birds
<b>Uses/Comments:</b>	Fast growing plant; Good for riparian restoration; Moderate salt tolerance
