

Berkeley Sedge

Carex tumulicola



CA Native:	Yes
Plant Community:	Coastal Prairie, Mixed Evergreen Forest, Yellow Pine Forest, Douglas-Fir Forest, Redwood Forests
Form:	Perennial grass
Size:	Up to 2' tall, 2' wide
Light:	Full sun to part shade
Water:	Drought tolerant, average water
WUCOLS:	1-4, 6 (M); 5 (N/A)
Soil:	Tolerates sand or clay, well drained or slightly wet
Flowers/Berries:	Cream, green or white flowers that are wind pollinated
Deer resistance:	Yes
Fire resistance:	Yes
Wildlife value:	Many species of small birds feed on seeds; occasionally used for nesting
Uses/Comments:	Can be used as groundcover or lawn substitute to create a natural meadow-like appearance. Cut back once a year to prevent seeding out.
