

# Joyce Coulter Ceanothus

## *Ceanothus joyce coulteri*



<b>CA Native:</b>	Yes
<b>Plant Community:</b>	Chaparral, Coastal Sage Scrub and Mixed-evergreen Forest.
<b>Form:</b>	Shrub
<b>Size:</b>	3-5' tall and 10-12' wide
<b>Light:</b>	Sun to partial shade
<b>Water:</b>	Little to moderate water
<b>WUCOLS:</b>	1-4 (L); 5-6 (N/A)
<b>Soil:</b>	Very adaptable; best in well-drained soils
<b>Flowers/Berries:</b>	Clusters of medium blue flowers in winter and spring
<b>Deer resistance:</b>	Yes
<b>Fire resistance:</b>	Yes
<b>Wildlife value:</b>	Attracts birds and butterflies
<b>Uses/Comments:</b>	Needs shade and increased water in warm inland areas
