

'Yankee Point' Ceanothus

Ceanothus thyrsiflorus var. *griseus*



CA Native:	Yes
Plant Community:	Chaparral, Closed-cone Pine Forest, Mixed-evergreen Forest and Yellow Pine Forest.
Form:	Shrub
Size:	3' tall and 10-12' wide
Light:	Full sun to part shade
Water:	Little water
WUCOLS:	1-4 (L); 5-6 (N/A)
Soil:	Adaptable. Tolerates alkaline soils, sand and clay
Flowers/Berries:	Showy light to medium blue flowers in clusters in spring
Deer resistance:	No
Fire resistance:	Yes
Wildlife value:	Attracts bees
Uses/Comments:	Useful as ground cover and as bank stabilizer
