Chilopsis linearis



CA Native:	Yes
Plant Community:	Creosote Bush Scrub, Joshua Tree Woodland, Riparian
Form:	Deciduous shrub
Size:	15-40' in height and width
Light:	Sun
Water:	Little water
WUCOLS:	1-3 (VL); 4 (L); 5-6 (M)
Soil:	Tolerates alkaline soil, clay, and sand
Flowers/Berries:	Light to bright pink clusters of trumpet-shaped flowers from mid-spring to summer.
Deer resistance:	No
Fire resistance:	No
Wildlife value:	Attracts many hummingbirds
Uses/Comments:	Dormant plant stems should not be pruned in winter until established for at least one year.
