

Honey Mesquite

Prosopis glandulosa



CA Native:	Yes
Plant Community:	Alkali Sink and Creosote Bush Scrub
Form:	Evergreen or deciduous tree
Size:	20-30' tall, sometimes multi-trunked
Light:	Full sun
Water:	Little to moderate water
WUCOLS:	1 (N/A); 2-4 (L); 5-6 (M)
Soil:	Adaptable
Flowers/Berries:	Small spikes of greenish-yellow flowers in spring, followed by 2-6" pods
Deer resistance:	Moderate
Fire resistance:	Moderate
Wildlife value:	Attracts birds, butterflies, and bees
Uses/Comments:	Smaller and shrubby with little or no water, moderate water results in rapid annual growth
