CA Native:	Yes
Plant Community:	Sierra foothills, interior Coast Ranges, interior valleys from southern Oregon to Southern California
Form:	Evergreen Tree
Size:	30-75' high x 30-75+' wide
Light:	Full sun
Temperature:	Sunset zones 7-9, 14-16, 18-21; Will survive down to 35° F
Water:	Little to no water in summer or risk disease
WUCOLS:	1-4 (VL); 5 (M); 6 (N/A)
Soil:	Well drained
Flowers/Berries:	Flowers spring; Acorns fall
Deer resistance:	Yes
Fire resistance:	No
Wildlife value:	Provides cover and nesting sites for birds; Acorns provide food
Uses/Comments:	Good for parks and large lawns; Nice looking tree when mature; Good for screen or wind-break
