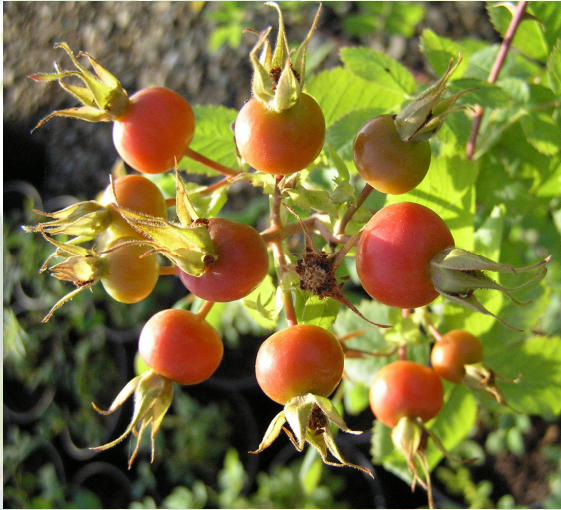


California Rose

CA Native:	Yes; Also north to Oregon
Plant Community:	Chaparral, Foothill Woodland; Below 6,000'
Form:	Deciduous shrub
Size:	3-6' high x 3-6' wide
Light:	Full sun to part shade
Temperature:	Will survive down to -20°F; Moderately heat tolerant
Water:	Drought tolerant; Minimum 20" per year
WUCOLS:	1-4 (L); 5-6 (N/A)
Soil:	Adaptable, but needs good drainage
Flowers/Berries:	Pink flowers spring-fall on old wood
Deer resistance:	No
Fire resistance:	No
Wildlife value:	Rosehips provide food for birds
Uses/Comments:	Flowers form on old wood so use caution when pruning
